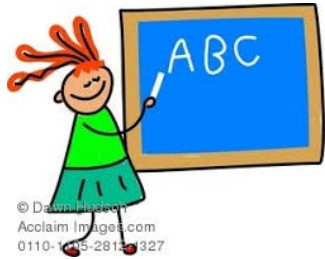


# SPELLING GRID

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**1. AROUND and AROUND**  
Start writing your words in a large circle. Continue until you reach the middle of the circle.



**2. QUIZ**  
Write quiz questions for each of your spelling words. Give it to a friend to solve.  
*Do you know how to use this word?*

**3. WORD VALUES**  
Work out the value of each of your words if a=1, b=2, c=3, d=4 etc.

**4. FANCY FONTS**  
Write your words with fancy letters.

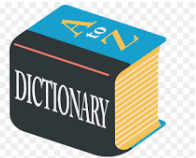


**5. RHYME TIME**  
Write your spelling words and next to each one write as many words that rhyme with your spelling word.

**6. STORY**  
Write a story using as many of your spelling words as possible.



**7. DICTIONARY WORK**  
Using a dictionary find the meanings of 5 your spelling words.



**8. FLASH CARDS**  
Make flash cards for your words. Draw a picture of the word on one side and spell the word correctly on the other side.



**9. GRAFFITI WORDS**  
Write your spelling words like graffiti.



**10. FEEL YOUR WAY**  
Use play dough to create your spelling words. Use a blind fold and ask a family member to test you on the words by feeling the words and guessing each one. (Collect the play dough from class)



**11. CELEBRITY HEAD**  
On small cards, write each of your spelling words so you can play 'Celebrity Head'



**12. MAKE A GAME OF IT!**  
Make a spelling word game. Ask your classmates to try it and rate it.

( If you need cardboard please come and ask)



**13. ADULT PRACTISE**  
Give an adult a test using your spelling words. Correct any mistakes. ( Parents make a few mistakes for extra practise!)

**14. MAGAZINE WORDS**  
Using magazines, catalogues etc, cut out the letters that you need to make your spelling words.



**15. COMPUTER WORDS**  
Type up your words on the computer. Change the fonts and the colour.



**16. GET DIRTY!**  
Use a baking tray to trace letters in salt, flour or shaving cream. (Use a cotton bud to write the letters).



**17. SYNONYMS**  
Write your spelling words and next to each word, write a word that means the same thing.
