

## READING ACTIVITY GRID

### Letter to the Author

Write a letter to the author of your story telling them why you liked the book. Let them know if you've read any of their other books too.

### Book Review

Write a book review of the story. Remember to include the title, author, a summary of the story, the main characters, your opinion of the book, a star review and whether or not you recommend it for others to read.

### Comic Strip

Draw a comic strip retelling the most important parts of the story.

### Board Game

Design a board game using characters and events from the story.

### Adjectives

Write a list of as many different adjectives as you can find in your novel. Can you find 20? 50? 100?  
Highlight any adjectives that you learnt reading this book.

### Character Comparison

Choose your favourite character from the story and compare them to yourself. How are you similar? How are you different? Try and come up with at least 10 reasons for each. You could present it as a Venn diagram (2 interlinked circles).

### Word Search

Create a word search with names of characters and words that relate to the story.

### Characters

Who were the main characters in the story?  
Write a paragraph describing the main characters, and draw a picture of each character.

### Secret Code

Create a code relating to the text. Use numbers or design your own symbols to represent the letters.

### Maps

Draw and label a map of one of the areas, rooms or landscapes in your text.

### Collage

Make a collage using images, words, topics from the text.

### Pamphlet

Design a pamphlet to persuade others to read the book.
