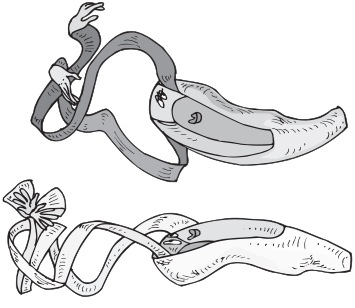


## Writing Test I – Narrative Identity



Today you are going to write a narrative or story. The idea for your story is “Identity”.

Your story might be about a person’s identity as a part of a family, a cultural group or religion. Your characters might identify with being part of a sporting team or a social group such as the Scouts or Guides. Your story might even be about changing identities as an actor or a secret agent does.

Your story could involve people joining a group or the problems caused if people are left out. It might be that a family identity changes through marriage or divorce, or someone unusual moves in.

As we grow older, our identities change as we do new activities and make new friends. Sometimes the most difficult thing is being an individual and not being like everyone else.

### Think about:

- the characters and where they are
- the complication or problem to be resolved
- how the story will end

- plan your story before you start
- write in sentences
- pay attention to the words you choose, your spelling and punctuation
- check and edit your writing when you have finished.
