## **Curriculum Days**

One of the important functions of school council is approving Curriculum Days.

This week a new fence has gone up at the back of the gym to ensure people do not fall down the embankment, particularly the 1 metre or so between the steep shotcrete wall and the top basketball courts fence. The irrigation system has been tested and is working, and freshly laid plants and tanbark are everywhere!

The new shotcrete wall between the gym and the main building looks great, and still some works to be completed with the ramp, concrete path and the new 'mini-oval' at the top of the new stairs and bleachers. As always – some pics below for you to check out!
