School Council

School Council met on Monday evening. A lot of time was spent on 2 main items—the building project and child safety training for school councilors.

Now that the building contractors have basically left the site, we have a better understanding of the state of the grounds that was behind the fences—e.g. the senior playground. There is some money left over for some works, school council needs to prioritise a list of items that will give us the 'biggest bang for our buck'. We will keep you informed as we go.

Interschool Sport

Last Friday was the first round of Interschool Sport for the year. One of the great opportunities we have as a small school is that our Year 4, 5 and 6 students are involved. At much larger schools, they have a situation where only Year 6 students can participate. From time-to-time, this can mean that we will have the occasional 'blow-out' in scores.
