Principal's Passage Mr Patrick Walsh

Lock Down

At the time of sending, greater Melbourne remains in lockdown until at least Thursday 10th June at 11:59pm.

We would like to thank you all for reading the Compass updates that I have been sending, and responding to requests as soon as possible. I have had to refuse some parent requests for onsite supervision as their current situation did not meet the criteria set out by the Department of Education and Training (DET), and the state government. As a government school, we must follow the directions given to us by our employer — DET.

I watch for the number of cases each day, and I normally try and watch the first 5-10 minutes of the daily press conference. This is so I can try and get a sense for myself what is going on. Unfortunately, the media (social, mainstream, alternative) will view the information through their own lens—as no doubt I do too.

We are very proud of the way our teachers and students have picked up where they left off last year—muscle memory is a wonderful thing! We also really appreciate what you are doing with your children at home—we know that it is not easy. As a parent, I know that most days my children are compliant, happy and willing to be involved. However, there are some days when they just need a late start and a little more time to get moving. If your children are having 'one of those days', leave their work until later in the day. Chances are you are working from home so it is important that you are focused on keeping food on the table and a roof over your heads.

If on the off chance things continue, it is very important that you respond to any requests for onsite supervision as soon as possible.

I will continue to provide you with pertinent updates as they come to hand.
