Coronavirus Update

As communicated to you last night via Compass, DET has provided updated advice regarding government restrictions and how these impact our school operations.

The 1 person per 4m² rule is still in effect, and masks must continue to be worn inside buildings. This means that, unfortunately, we still cannot have parents in school buildings. Parent Helpers for PMP will need to wait for Term 3 before returning.

The use of Service Victoria QR codes for electronic record keeping is now mandatory in all schools to enable the effective contact tracing of any COVID-19 cases.

All schools are required to have QR codes in place. QR code use will continue into Term 3 until further notice.

QR code check ins are required to be used by:

- all visitors on school site (including contractors, external Department staff and building and maintenance staff)
- all parents who enter school buildings.

QR code check ins are not required to be used by:

- staff
- Students
- parents who come onto school grounds for drop off or pick up, but do not enter buildings.

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Principal's Passage (continued)

Persistent mild symptoms

Some children may have prolonged post-viral symptoms such as a runny nose or cough. They may return to school following a negative COVID-19 test even if they are not completely free of symptoms. They will need a medical certificate from their GP to confirm they are otherwise well or have recovered from their acute illness.

Any worsening of symptoms will require review and repeat COVID-19 testing, if considered appropriate by the doctor.

Students with a negative COVID-19 test whose symptoms have completely resolved do not need a medical certificate to return to the school.

The staff have worked their backsides off to provide the best learning opportunities they can in these uncertain times. However, student learning has been interrupted.

Please note, this is subject to any coronavirus restrictions that will be in place at that time.


