COVID-19 vaccination directions for education workers

The Victorian Chief Health Officer has issued directions for required vaccinations for education workers. These directions are specific to education workers and supersede those for other authorised workers.

An education worker is:

- any person who is employed by an education operator to work in an education facility (including teachers, early childhood educators and educational support staff);
- person contracted to work at an education facility and who will or may be in close proximity to children, students or staff, whether or not engaged by the education operator including casual relief teachers, Breakfast Club suppliers, IT personnel, NDIS providers and auditors (but does not include delivery personnel);
- staff of the Department of Education and Training who attend an education facility (such as allied health personnel or Authorised Officers);
- staff of any other entity who attends an education facility;
- volunteers that attend an education facility and that work in close proximity to children, students or staff (including parent helpers); and
- students on placements at an education facility.

All education workers are required:

- by 18 October to have had a first dose of the vaccine or produce evidence of a booking to receive a vaccine by 25 October 2021; and
- by 29 November 2021 to be fully vaccinated unless a medical exemption applies, and to show evidence of their vaccination status.

Research Primary School Return to Onsite Learning Plan

All information regarding the return to Onsite Learning Plan will be communicated to you via Compass. There have been a number of schools that have had short term shut downs due to cases of coronavirus. We will be implementing the Department of Education and Training's (DET) advice in regards to the return as closely as possible. This will include designated drop off and pick up points for certain year levels.

I have just been informed that face masks will be compulsory for all students in Grades 3 – 6 from the 18th October. I will provide more information about this as it comes to hand.

Melbourne Cup Weekend

On Monday 1st November, we have a School Council approved Curriculum Day—there will be no school, on onsite supervision or OSHClub on this day. Tuesday 2nd November is a Public Holiday.

Prep 2022 Information Evening

We are conducting a Prep Information Evening on Tuesday 9th November at 6:30pm. In the current circumstances, this will need to occur on-line and is only for those families who have confirmed their 2022 Prep enrolment. A link will be sent to these families in the week or 2 leading up to the event. If you have a child to enrol for Prep in 2022, and you have not yet handed in an enrolment form, please do so as soon as possible.



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Capital Works

I would like to inform you that we will be having some extra works completed over the next 6 months or so (subject to all things covid).

A fairly major issue at the school has been the lack of adequate drainage. The recent completed building works has significantly reduced what I have heard termed from others as 'waterfalls' in big rain events around the school. However, as many of you know, the damage done of many years has left our driveways (particularly going up to the gym) in disrepair. The Victorian School Building Authority has engaged the company 'Urban Initiatives' https://www.urbaninitiatives.com.au/ to look at our drainage and to repair much of the asphalted driveways and car parks.

We are very lucky to have the VSBA approve this as, in my experience at other schools, they do not do this type of work. They have recognised that due to the location of the school on a main road, it is necessary for us to have this on the school site in the interests of student safety.
