Diamond Creek Bluelight Community Sentiment Survey

The Diamond Creek Bluelight Disco has been in operation since 1992 with many parents returning with their children. The association has been able to donate several hundreds of thousands of dollars to youth programs & sporting clubs over the years. Owing to the Covid 19 restrictions we have not been able to hold the disco events for the last two years and prior to Covid we saw attendees reduce. Planning is underway to re-introduce the disco events. However, we are keen to gauge the level of community support and expected patronage to the dance.

We plan eight (8) dance events each year for the Diamond Valley youth aged 8 years to 13 years. They are held on Friday evenings from 7pm to 10pm. Once the children have paid and passed through into the hall, they remain under the care of the volunteer off duty Police and CFA until a parent / guardian come into the hall and collect them.
