Welcome to the 2024 school year. The students in Year 1 & 2 have all settled in well and have been enjoying renewing friendships and making new ones. The Year 1/2 Team will continue to work closely together this year.

We are really looking forward to a very exciting and rewarding year ahead with many new, fun, and inspiring activities planned for the students.

The aim for the year ahead is to develop the student's independence, to encourage them to problem solve in everyday situations, promote responsibility, help them learn to make their own decisions, develop their strengths and provide experiences where a range of learning styles are explored.

Reading: In Reading the students will be learning to find 'Good Fit' books and building up their reading stamina. You will also find your child's Reading Eggs password on the inside of their Reading Logs.

Home Reading: Remember to change book daily.

Maths: The focus in Maths will be Place Value and Statistics & Graphing.

Integrated Studies: Students will be undertaking the 'Marvellous Me– My Story, Your Story, Our Story' unit, History. We will be investigating personal histories and change.

P.B.L: The Year 1/2 students will be involved in Project Based Learning which will provide them with the opportunity to develop new strategies and promote student voice.

Wellbeing: Through our Wellbeing and Respectful Relations sessions, the students will describe a wide range of emotions and recognise feelings. They will look at developing empathy, care and practise social skills.

Art: In Art this term the Year 1/2s will investigate portrait drawing and complete a whole school collaborative artwork. They will investigate the art elements of colour, line and shape through a variety of mediums. Miss Kepitis

Science: In Science this term, we will be exploring what is inside the human body by taking a closer look at our bones and organs. In this Epic Human Body project, the children will be making a replica of themselves to show their learning. Mrs Skeen

Physical Education: This term our Year 1/2 students will be focusing on the basics and rules of field hockey, tennis, and cricket. We kickstart all our sessions with energetic tag games and fundamental motor skill activities. Mr O'Halloran
