Morning and Afternoon Procedures

At the start of each day the children will (try to) line up in their 4 lines outside the main door ready to come into the classroom when the bell rings. (We have found that this helps eliminate some of the separation anxiety that can sometimes occur.) We will pop outside before the bell for a quick chat. Please feel free to ask any questions or share important information with us at this time.

After school we will usually take the children outside the room at around 3.20pm - 3.25pm. This avoids congestion with the other classes and makes sure that they are delivered safely back to you. HOWEVER please do not worry if you do not arrive until 3.30pm or a little after. Please remind your child that they MUST stay with us in the small area outside the door until they see you. A little wave to us to show they have been picked up would really be appreciated!

Lunches

We try hard to check that each child is eating their 'healthy, growing' food. Please let us know if you are concerned in any way.

Canteen Orders

There will be a Prep B and a Prep O tub inside the classroom where the children place their lunch orders on canteen days. If they have money to spend at 'counter sales' please check with them that they know where to find it.

Term 1 Curriculum Overview

This term our main focus is to set the kids up for success by helping them to establish meaningful connections at school as well as becoming familiar with the complex rules, routines and daily expectations.

In **Maths** this term we will explore patterns, classify objects and begin to focus on the specific properties of the numbers 1 to 10 as well as counting up to and beyond 100! We will experiment with capacity and mass.

In **English** we will examine words that rhyme and words that begin with the same sound. We will begin to introduce the high frequency words as well as formally teaching letter sound relationships. We will focus on 1 to 1 pointing in a text and begin to read simple repetitive books. (Very exciting!)

Project Learning (Creative and Critical Thinking)

In Project Learning the children are encouraged to follow their own interests, extend their ideas, think creatively, solve their own problems and work cooperatively together.

This term we will be providing a range of Maths, Science, Art, Dramatic play, as well as sensory experiences, for the children to explore and discover new ideas.

In **PE** we will be participating in our Perceptual Motor Program (PMP) where we will work on a range of movement activities aimed to improve eye/hand and eye/foot coordination, fitness, balance, locomotion and eye-tracking skills. We will be promoting enjoyment of movement and exercise.

In **Science** this term, we will be exploring what is inside the human body by taking a closer look at our bones and organs. The children will be making a replica of themselves to show their learning.

During **Library** sessions, Prep students will be sharing their feelings and thoughts about the events and characters depicted in the stories we read. As students have commenced borrowing, this is a friendly reminder that library books are on loan for 2 weeks.

In Art this term the Preps will investigate portrait drawing and complete a whole school collaborative artwork. They will be exposed to the art elements of colour and line through a variety of mediums.
