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Term 2 Curriculum Overview

English

In Reading, our preps will continue expanding their repertoire of high-frequency words, empowering them with the tools they need to unlock a multitude of simple texts. In phonics, they will focus on the sounds and relationships of the letters S, I, T, P, A, R, N, H, and D. We'll also focus on refining the mechanics of reading, including decoding skills and the crucial practice of one-to-one pointing. The preps will be introduced to comprehension strategies to support them in understanding, interpreting, and connecting to texts. Please continue to support your child with reading at home. We strongly encourage reading a text each night. Please remember to log them in your child's Home Reading Journal, this is where we will also include some notes for you to read.

In Writing, there will be a continued focus on fundamental handwriting skills, honing in on letter formation and spacing. A highlight of our writing sessions this term will be our weekly "diary" entries, where preps will have the opportunity to recount their weekend adventures. This will help foster creativity and self-expression but also encouraging them to attempt writing familiar words and construct simple sentences. We will support them to transfer their knowledge of the "Magic Words" and known letter sounds into their writing.

In Speaking and Listening, later in the term, our preps will take part in a special "show and share" session. They'll share cool facts about their favourite place, tying into our integrated topic, "*Me and My Environment.*" Very exciting! More details to come closer to the date!

Numeracy

In Number, the preps will focus on the specific properties of the numbers 1-10. They will also begin to look at ordinal numbers and place numbers in their corresponding spot (before, in-between or after). We will also be introducing Math Seeds, your child can access this program at home using their Reading Eggs Login.

In Measurement, we will explore time, looking at days of the week and the four seasons. Later in the term we will be experimenting with length.

Integrated Studies

In Geography, this term we will be exploring the unit, 'Me and My Environment' where the students will investigate the origins and significance of names, features and places in their local area, and explore our connection to them. They will delve into historical, cultural, and geographical factors shaping these places, fostering a deeper understanding of our local community. As part of this unit, the preps will be participating in 4 local walking excursions (see dates and location on the previous page).

In Project Learning (Creative and Critical Thinking) the children are encouraged to follow their own interests, extend their ideas, think creatively, solve their own problems and work cooperatively together. This term we will have a focus on bio-science, including planting bulbs around the school. We will also be diving into the world of weaving, creating a variety of different pieces.

Specialist

In PE we will continue participating in our Perceptual Motor Program (PMP) where they will work on a range of movement activities aimed to improve their eye/hand and eye/foot coordination, fitness, balance, locomotion and eye-tracking skills. We will be promoting enjoyment of movement and exercise. The Preps will also participate in the Junior School Athletics Day.

In Science this term, we will be exploring Earth's resources by taking a closer look at minerals, rocks, soil and water. Students will identify how these resources are used at school and home, along with how to conserve them.

During Library sessions, Prep students will explore the features of a story, how characters are introduced and how stories begin. This is a friendly reminder that library books are on loan for 2 weeks.

In Art during Term 2 the Preps will continue to investigate the art elements of colour and line through a variety of mediums. There will be a focus on the colour wheel, and primary and secondary colours.
