# Term Planners—Excursions & Incursion Charges

With price increases across the board, not only in the supermarket due to the general cost of living raises but some excursions / incursions have increased by up to 30%!! This is due to bus hire, organisations new fee structure etc. We thought it would be an ideal time to explain to parents about term planners.

Term planners outline the costs for the children's activities each term and are sent out close to the start of each term. The costs itemised on Term Planners only cover the activities and excursions etc where <u>all</u> children in the class will be attending. Events such as a visiting show, the whole class trip to the zoo and so on.

Based on current costs we believe the approximate 2024 year costs per student for the 4x term planners could be:

Preps: \$350 Grade 1: \$400 Grade 2: \$400 Grade 3: \$500

Grade 4: \$500 Grade 5: \$600 Grade 6: \$600

A few other activities where, not all children in the class attend or only selected competitors represent the school, such as: District Sports or emergency bus booking for gym or swimming will require separate permission / payment requests. These extra costs can vary between \$20 - \$80 per child. Unfortunately, there is no simple way around the need for these separate permission and payments notes.

The school camp is separate again, costing approximately \$450 per head for years 3 - 6, with payment plans & instalments in place to ease the cost on families.

Please note the following payment options are available to families if needed:

Payment plan (to pay off debt)

Ongoing direct deposit (into family account)

Hardship Support (discuss with Principal)

Please feel free to reach out with other suggestions or requests and we will try to accommodate.
