
Enrolling with OSHClub is Free and Highly Recommended

Swimming Team Selection Trials

Attention Year 3-6 families! Notes have been sent home for students **interested in trying out** for the Research Primary School Swimming Team. This is an opt in event.

The selection trials will take place on Friday, 14th February at Eltham College swimming pool. To be eligible, students must be able to swim at least 50 metres in one of the following strokes: freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke, or butterfly.

We encourage all capable swimmers to participate; however, please note that students must be able to complete the full 50 metres without stopping, holding onto the lane rope, or breaking stroke. Unfortunately, students who cannot meet these requirements will not be eligible for the team.

If selected, your child will represent Research Primary at the Eltham District Swimming Carnival on Friday, 21st February @ WaterMarc.
