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# **Prep News**

### **Term 2 Curriculum Overview**

### English

In Reading, our preps will continue expanding their repertoire of high-frequency words, empowering them with the tools they need to unlock a multitude of simple texts. In phonics, they will focus on the sounds and relationships of the letters C, K, CK, E, H, G, O, H, U, L, F, B, J and Y. We'll also focus on refining the mechanics of reading, including decoding skills and the crucial practice of one-to-one pointing. The preps will be introduced to comprehension strategies to support them in understanding, interpreting, and connecting to texts. Please continue to support your child with reading at home. We strongly encourage reading a text each night. Please remember to log them in your child's Home Reading Journal, this is where we will also include some notes for you to read.

In Writing, there will be a continued focus on fundamental handwriting skills, honing in on letter formation and spacing. A highlight of our writing sessions this term will be our weekly "diary" entries, where preps will have the opportunity to recount their weekend adventures. This will help foster creativity and self-expression but also encouraging them to attempt writing familiar words and construct simple sentences. We will support them to transfer their knowledge of the "Magic Words" and known letter sounds into their writing.

In Speaking and Listening, later in the term, our preps will take part in a special "show and share" session. They'll share cool facts about their favourite animal, tying into our integrated topic, '*Is it Alive?*'. For more information and your child's allocated time please see the attached sheet.

#### Numeracy

In Number, the preps will focus on the specific properties of the numbers 5-10. They will also begin to look at ordinal numbers and place numbers in their corresponding spot (before, in-between or after). We will also be introducing Math Seeds, your child can access this program at home using their Reading Eggs Login.

In Measurement, we will be exploring the concept of time by learning about the days of the week and the vocabulary related to different times of the day, and connecting these to familiar daily events.

### **Integrated Studies**

In Science, we're diving into our exciting unit, 'Is It Alive?'. Students will become young scientists as they explore the differences between living and non-living things and learn what plants and animals need to survive — air, water, food, and shelter. We're thrilled to be heading off to Healesville Sanctuary, where students will see a range of animals up close and find out how each one meets its needs in the wild. They'll also be encouraged to think about how they care for pets or plants at home. Back in the classroom, students will get their hands dirty planting seeds and bulbs, learning how to nurture them as they grow. It's sure to be a term full of wonder, curiosity, and life!

In Project Learning (Creative and Critical Thinking) the children are encouraged to follow their own interests, extend their ideas, think creatively, solve their own problems and work cooperatively together. This term we will have a focus on bio-science, living and non-living. This will include planting and growing a range of seeds and bulbs.

### **Specialist**

This PE, Prep students will be getting ready for our Junior School Athletics Day by developing their fundamental motor skills. They will also take part in the Perceptual Motor Program (PMP) twice a week on Wednesday and Thursday afternoons, focusing on coordination, balance, and movement skills.

In Science and Technology, students will embark on a journey to uncover what is beneath our feet. They will investigate the Earth's surface and discover how fossils are created when living things are buried and preserved over time. Through the unit Beneath Our Feet, students will examine different types of fossils and learn how these ancient remains provide valuable clues about what the Earth looked like in the past and the plants and animals that once lived there.

In Art this term the Preps will investigate the art elements of Colour and Line. They will learn about the colour wheel and primary and secondary colours, and create artworks using different styles of lines.

In Library Prep students will take part in engaging library sessions where they explore different areas of the library and enjoy a variety of books. These sessions are designed to encourage students to borrow books to take home and to nurture a love of reading.
