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Students — late arrival or leaving early

Please remember to **always** sign your child into school, at the office, if they are late in the morning and sign them out of school if they are leaving early. Children's attendance is taken from Compass and reported to the Department of Education, which is a legal obligation. Also unexplained absences will show on your child's report. If you have trouble entering an absence on Compass, please either call or email the office and Carol or Jac will be happy to enter the details for you.

Arriving at school

The school yard is not supervised until 8.45am, unless your child is booked in with OSHClub, for safety reasons, please ensure you do not drop your children off too early.

Enrolling with OSHClub is Free and Highly Recommended

We have an awesome OSHClub that runs before school and after school care here at RPS and it's free to enrol. However, you **must** have your children enrolled to attend, even on a casual or last minute basis. If you are running late to collect your child, the school office is happy to look after your child for a few minutes but if you end up being, say over 15 minutes late, you should arrange to have them sent to OSHClub until you arrive. We are at the point where we are trying to gather information that is very specific to the individuals who frequent our community. "We are interested in better understanding our communities needs when it comes to pedestrian access and support for students and their families attending Research Primary School. Several families have raised concerns regarding the lack of school crossing or pedestrian support for students and their families when walking to and from school. With increasing school enrolments and levels of traffic in the area the risks for students and their families when walking to and from school have changed. To support advocacy for a review please answer the following questions regarding your experience both walking and driving around the school. We will use responses to support discussions regarding potential solutions with Nillumbik Shire Council.

The survey is open to the community, however, has a focus on the safety of students during school times. Please share with anyone in your family's support network who would like to contribute or has an experience they feel is relevant to our understanding of the issue.

The following questions are to better understand the problems families, or the community see as important regarding pedestrian safety for students walking to and from school. Even if you do not have children at the school, we welcome your input if you walk, drive, or live near the school".


The BBQ will run from 8am to 4pm. All shifts currently available.




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Get Active with Tennis and Pickleball at the Research Tennis Club.
